## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. In Race 5 while on the run in leg 3, 10 was attempting to overtake 101.
- 2. 10 was in 4th place behind 101 in 3rd place.
- 3. The sea was flat with 7 to 8 knots of wind
- 4. A fast passing boat created substantial wake.
- 5. 10 capsized but 101 managed to stay upright.
- 6. Both 10 and 101 could not under those circumstances identify the vessel that created the wake and if it was an RC vessel.
- 7. After the capsize, 10 recovered and remained 4th behind 101 who was still 3rd.
- 8. There were 8 entries in the Laser Standard class.

## CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. 10 was 4th before the incident and remained 4th after the incident and therefore did not meet the criteria of having lost significant places from the capsize.
- 2. It could not be established if it was an RC's improper action that resulted in the wake that caused the capsize.
