NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Appendices that will apply:
 - 1.3.1 Appendix P will apply as stated in NOR 11.1
 - 1.3.2 Appendix T, as amended in the Sailing Instructions, will apply.
- 1.4 STCR 35.5 changes the Two-Turn penalty in RRS 44.1 and P2.1 to a One-Turn Penalty as defined in RRS 44.2.
- 1.5 RRS 32 will not apply.
- 1.6 The course length can be altered under RRS 33(b) within the leg length applicable for the format of the regatta.
- 1.7 RRS 35 and A5 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within the limits established in STCR 34.6.3 after the first boat sails the course and *finishes* within the time limit will be scored TLE as defined in the STCR.
- 1.8 Boats may carry VHF radios for purposes of safety and for receiving race committee communication, including notification of OCS boats. Race Committee failure to notify, delay notification, and the order announced will not be grounds for redress.
- 1.9 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Entries are open to all active, life and isolated skippers and must be eligible in accordance with STCR 26.1. Crews must comply with STCR 26.2. Boats must comply with STCR 21.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the on-line application before 14th May 2021.
- 3.3 Entries received after 14th May 2021, will be subject to a late fee. Late entries may be accepted till the end of registration by the discretion of the organizing committee.
- 3.4 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under WS Eligibility Code, Regulation 19, are to compete in this regatta.
- 3.5 A Competitor is not entered and will not receive a score until: (a) All fees are paid; (b) Measurement and crew weight-in are completed; and (c) Proof of insurance is provided.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee of EUR 200 includes the Star Class fee, boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling-

- 4.3 The late entry fee of EUR 250 will be assessed entries received after 14th May 2021, given conformance to NOR 3.3.
- 4.4 The fee is not refundable, even if the entry is cancelled later on or the boat does not show up. Entry fees will only be refunded if the entry is rejected. Entry fee may be refunded in case of restriction to travel to and from the country entitled both from Croatia or from the Nation of the sailor.
- 4.5 In the new context COVID 19 the Organizing Committee may cancel the event and the entry fee will be entirely refunded. If an entry is cancelled by the competitor, it will be refunded as follows: - Before: 14.05.2021 80% - After: 14.05.2021 Not refunded. If a competitor will not be able to reach the venue due to COVID-19 related issues (e.g., infection, quarantine, or other restrictions) beyond the control of the competitor, the fee will be completely refunded.

5 OTHER FEES

- 5.1 Food voucher for each competitor and accompanying Support Person is 40 Eur which can be paid at the club office upon registration. (events plan to be confirmed)

6 SCHEDULE

6.2 6 races are scheduled.

7 MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 Teams shall demonstrate compliance with team weight limits in accordance with STCR 31.1.3

prior to end of inspection. Teams WILL NOT be subject to reweighing during the regatta subject to the exception in STCR 31.1.3.

- 7.3 Only boats that have completed registration, paid all entry fees and passed the prescribed measurement check procedure by 18:00 on May 20th, 2021 are entitled to race. The Jury may order that a boat re-checked during the regatta.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9 VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and racing areas.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be in accordance with STCR 34.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 RRS Appendix P will apply. RRS P2.2 and P2.3 will not apply. Penalties for breaches to rules other than those Part 2 and RRS 28 and 31, may be after instruction, from a 10% penalty out of the number of entered to a disqualification [DP]

11.2 Decisions of the international jury if duly constituted will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

12 SCORING

12.1 The scoring system is the Low Point System of RRS A.

12.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

13 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour.

14 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committee.

15 COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency or for a boat that is retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

16 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

16.1 The PERPETUAL TROPHY of the 17th District will be awarded.

16.2 Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through five.

16.3 The Organizing Authority reserves the right to provide additional prizes.

17 TEAM AND PRIVATE SUPPORT PERSONS AND BOATS

- 17.1 Individual and support / coach boat shall register with the OA during registration at the regatta registration office and shall comply with the RRS and the STCR.
- 17.2 Support boats and persons shall carry a functioning VHF and monitor the required channel and shall assist the Race Committee if requested.
- 17.3 The Sailing Instructions and/or the OA may further limit the activities of the support boats.
- 17.4 All Support Vessels shall be equipped with a functioning engine safety cut-out switch (kill switch) which shall remain attached to the support person at the helm at all times while the engine is running. Failure to comply may be misconduct and/or result in expulsion from the event. [DP]

18 DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

19 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,500,000.00 per incident or the equivalent.
