## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

## **FACTS FOUND**

On the second upwind, shortly after the leeward mark rounding, 80 was clear ahead, 66 and 65 overlapped clear astern, 65 to leeward of 66, all on starboard.

80 tacked to port ahead of 65 and 66. 65 and 66 bore away and there was light contact between 66's hand and 65's board. 65 and 66 passed astern of 80.

No tangle or injury occured and no kiteboard took a penalty.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

80 on port did not keep clear of 65 and 66 on starboard breaking rule 10

66 to windward did not keep clear of 65 to leeward breaking rule 11 and 14 but is exonerated as she was compelled to do so by 80 breaking rule 10

Protest Upheld 80 is DSQ in race 5
