PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Hasl Free notified Jim of her protest verbally shortly after the incident.
- 2. Because the incident involved serious damage and injury, the requirements of 61.1(a) did not apply to Hasl Free.
- 3. Has! Free and Jim were sailing to the windward mark on the third leg (out of six) in race 6, approximately 4 boatlengths from the mark.
- 4. Hasl Free was sailing on starboard tack, and Jim was sailing on port tack on an intersecting course.
- 5. Jim altered course to leeward to pass astern of Hasl Free, while Hasl Free held her course.
- 6. The main trimmer on Jim did not release her mainsail.
- 7. There was contact between the bow of Jim and the port side of Hasl Free.
- 8. Both the deck and the hull of *Hasl Free* were open to the sea after the contact.
- 9. A crew member of *Hasl Free* suffered a broken ankle.
- 10. Both boats retired from race 6.
- 11. Neither boat sailed in race 7 of the series.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. It was not reasonably for *Hasl Free* to avoid contact when it became clear that *Jim* was not going to *keep clear*. Therefore, *Hasl Free* did not break rule 14.
- 2. Jim as a port tack boat, failed to keep clear of Hasl Free, on starboard and thus broke rule 10. She also broke rule 14.

3. Because Jim retired from race 6, she took an appropriate penalty, and cannot be penalized further.

No further penalty for Jim

Hasl Free, average points for races 6 and 7, to the nearest tenth of a point, based on her results from races 1 through 5.

No other boat's scores for races 6 and 7 shall be adjusted.
