PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Member of the jury was not available because of illness and no qualified replacement was available. The International jury remained properly constituted with 4 members, including 2 International judges under rule N1.5.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind was about 4 knots and flat water.
- 2. Boats were approaching mark 2P which should be passed to port.
- 3. FRA on port entered the zone clear ahead of LAT on port.
- 4. FRA slowed down while rounding the mark.
- 5. LAT overtook the FRA and get overlapped inside and to windward of FRA.
- 6. Contact occurred between midship of FRA and bow of LAT causing scratches in gelcoat of FRA.
- 7. No boat took a penalty.
- 8. After the incident, the race was abandoned.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. LAT, the windward overlapped boat, failed to keep clear of FRA breaking RRS 11 and 14.
- 2. LAT, clear astern at the time fra reached the zone, failed to give fra mark-room, as required by RRS 18.2(b)
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for FRA to avoid contact and did not break RRS 14.
- 4. RRS 36(b) applied as the race was abandoned.

DECISION

Protest upheld. No further penalty to LAT.
