### **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

#### FACTS FOUND

- 1. MAS and SIN were maneuvering during the pre-start. Wind-speed was 9-12kts. The sea state was choppy.
- 2. About 3 minutes before the start, and 3 boat lengths below the line, MAS was head-to-wind having been on starboard tack.
- 3. SIN gained a leeward overlap. SIN luffed, and MAS kept 1 boat width apart.
- 4. About 3-5 seconds afterwards SIN luffed hard, and MAS promptly luffed and then tacked . There was no contact.
- 5. There was no damage or injury.
