FACTS FOUND

- 1. 0521 was starting near the pin end of the starting line.
- 2. The RC had an official sighting the line on the pin end.
- 3. The officials on the pin boat relied on a radio transmission and sighting the flag on the race committee boat for determining the start time.
- 4. The officials on the pin boat sighting the line called several boats on the course side at the start.
- $5.\,$ The scribe for the RC on the pin end boat recorded 6812, $5948,\,0643\,0521$ on the course side after the time .
- 6. The line sight on the committee boat indicated there were no boats over early at the time they believed to be the start.
- 7. 0521 was scored OCS for race 3.
