1. Protest hailed, informed RC at the finish, lodged within protest time limit.

- 2. The hearing was interrupted by a storm at 19:30 that damaged the Jury tent where the protest was held. The hearing could not be continued due to the prevailing conditions.
- 3. The protest is rescheduled for 12May2019 at 0900am.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. W136 and W132 were reaching to the finish line in Race 5 with W136 initially ahead of W132
- 2. About 70 meters before the finish line, W136 was pumping and semi planing. W132 was planing.
- 3. When W132 was windward of W136, W136 dropped her sail but did not capsize.
- 3.W132 overtook W136 on the windward side and finished ahead of W136.
