## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. Wind 18kts, moderate current against
- 2. USA 332 on starboard tack layline approaching weather mark.
- 3. CAN 11 on port tack 1/2 length below layline approaching weather mark.
- 4. CAN11 tacked to starboard at the mark.
- 5, While CAN11 was tacking, USA 332 altered course to windward.
- 6. There was contact between the starboard corner of CAN11 transom and USA332 port bow about 8' aft of the bow.
- 7. The contact caused damage a 2" chip in the gelcoat of USA332

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

CAN11, a boat tacking did not keep clear of USA 332, a boat on a tack, breaking rule 13. USA332 altered course as soon as it was apparent that CAN11 was not keeping clear but was unable to avoid contact. As USA 332 did everything reasonably possible to avoid contact, she did not break rule 14.
