PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Shortly after the start of race 4, there was an incident between two unidentified kite boards which were sailing ahead and to leeward of NED 23
- 2. The unidentified kite boards changed the position of their kites and immediately NED 23 lifted her kite
- 3. In line, GER 88, ESP 51, GBR 10, MAR 69, GBR 17, BUL 72 and FRA 87 changed the position of their kites and multiple contacts and tangles occurred
- 4. NED 23 finished the race
- 5. There was damage on the kites of GER 88, MAR 69, BUL 72 and ESP 51
- 6. GER 88 returned ashore on another sailor's kite, changed equipment and started race 5
- 7. ESP 51, GBR 10, MAR 69, GBR 17, BUL 72 and FRA 87 were brought ashore on rescue boats at the start of race 5
- 8. FRA 87 started race 5 late and finished in 39th place
- 9. GBR 17 and BUL 72 did not start in race 5 but started in race 6 $\,$
- 10. ESP 51, GBR 10 and MAR 69 did not start in race 5 or race 6 $\,$

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. The unidentified right of way kiteboards, changed the position of their kites without giving room to NED 23 to keep clear, breaking rule 16.1 and 14
- 2. NED 23 broke rule 16.1
- 3. All of the other kiteboards broke rules but are exonerated because they were compelled to do so by a kite board breaking a rule
- 4. The score GER 88 was made significantly worse in race 4 through no fault of her own by a tangle caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2
- 5. The score of ESP 51, GBR 10, MAR 69, GBR 17, BUL 72 and FRA 87 was made significantly worse in races 4 and 5 through no fault of their own by a tangle caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2
- 6. The scores of ESP 51, GBR 10 and MAR 69 was not made significantly worse in race 6 through no fault of their own

- 1. GER 88 is given redress in race 4 and will be scored points equal to the average of her scores in the other races of the day rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other kiteboards.
- 2. ESP 51, GBR 10 and MAR 69 are given redress in races 4 and 5 and will be scored points equal to the average of their scores in races 1, 2 and
- 3, rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other kiteboards.
- 3. GBR 17, BUL 72 and FRA 87 are given redress in races 4 and 5 and will be scored points equal to the average of their scores in the other races of the day rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other kiteboards.
- 4. ESP 51, GBR 10 and MAR 69 are not given redress in race 6
