- 5.9 No warning signal will be made before 12:00 hours.

6 FORMAT

6.4 The format will be a single round robin, detailed in LSI Addendum D

7 STARTING AND FINISHING

- 7.1 The starting line for team member A will be between staffs displaying orange/white chequered flags on Race Committee vessels on both ends of the starting line.
- 7.1.1 The changeover starting line for team member B will be between a staff displaying flag R and the course side of the nearby changeover mark.
- 7.4 The table in RRS 26 is deleted and replaced with the following:

7.7 The finishing line race committee vessel is identified by a blue/white chequered flag. This changes RRS Race Signals.

 - The Official Flag Pole is located in front of the race office. Courtesy shore flag signals will be displayed at a flag pole in the launching area.
- 11.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in the race signal AP. This changes Race Signals.
