PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The hearing proceeded under RRS 63.3 as the protestee did not appear at the hearing.
- 2. At the finish of Race 5, USA 29 was approaching the pin end of the finish line on starboard gybe.
- 3. USA 153 was approaching USA 29 on port gybe on a collision course.
- 4. Boats were overlapped when the first of them entered the zone.
- 5. USA 153 gybe to starboard very near USA 29.
- 6. USA 29 crash gybed releasing his genaker.
- 7. USA 29 collided with the Pin boat anchor rode, fouling her keel and incurring unspecified damage to her hull
- 8. The contact caused damage to the Race Committee boat.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. USA 153 failed to keep clear of USA 29 and broke RRS 10.
- 2. USA 153 failed to give Mark Room to USA 29 and broke RRS 18.2(b).
- 3. USA 29 broke RRS 31, but is exonerated under RRS 21(b).

USA 153 shall be scored DSQ for Race 5.
