1038 on starboard tack downwind, 561 on port tack downwind on a collision course. 561 headed up and capsized onto 1038, who also capsized. Both boats were righted and continued the race. 1038 accpets that 561 did their penalty turns. Ther was no damage or injury.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1038 was on starboard, 561 was on port. 1038 did not think that 561 had taken sufficient action to avoid a collision. Both boats capsized. The was no damage or injury to either boat. 561 completed their penalty turns.

561 exonerated themselves by taking their penalty turns for the incident causing both boats to capsize.
