

## [2021-05-19-1] COVID-19 related regulations and links (updated daily)

2. **Rules for participating in an event**

(valid 2021-05-17 till 2021-05-23, updated weekly)

The competition participants can attend an event if they submit a negative result for the SARS-CoV-2 virus by polymerase chain reaction (PCR test) or rapid antigen test (HAG test). The test shouldn't be older than 72 hours, counting from the day and time of issuance of the test certificate. For example, if a person received a negative test on Friday at 8 a.m., the test is valid until Monday at 8 p.m. If the competition lasts for several days, competitors must have a test not older than 72 hours for each day.

The competition organizer is responsible for compliance with the Decree provisions on submitting a negative test for all participants in the competition.

Before entering the competition venue, the organizer requires all participants to provide appropriate evidence of compliance with PCT conditions:

- SARS-CoV-2 negative test certificate,
- vaccination or
- morbidity certificate / evidence,

and keep a list of participants from which it must be evident that the organizer has checked the participant's status.

Media representatives located or moving on or directly next to the competition area (in the so-called mix zone) should be treated as administrative staff involved in the implementation of the competitions.

3. **Wearing masks and disinfection**

A protective mask is mandatory when moving and staying at all sports facilities. Furthermore, the protective mask is also compulsory during sports activities, unless an interpersonal distance of at least 3 meters.

The use of a protective mask is also obligatory in open public places or spaces if it is not possible to ensure an interpersonal distance of at least 1.5 meters.

A coach who conducts sports training must wear a protective mask at all times, except during the implementation of sports training. For example, a coach wants to approach a trainee to show him the correct execution of the exercise. In that case, he must wear a protective mask.

Upon entering an enclosed public space, it is obligatory to disinfect hands with a disinfectant.
