### International Arrival in Abu Dhabi

- Present a Negative PCR test result within 96 hours prior to departure to Abu Dhabi
- Take a second test upon landing in Abu Dhabi
- Self-Isolate:
  - Travelers from pre-approved countries, must self-isolate until receive a negative test result
  - Travelers from other countries, must self-isolate for 10 days
- Take a PCR Test on day 6 and on day 12 after arrival

### International Arrival in Dubai

- Present a Negative PCR test result within 96 hours prior to departure to Dubai
- You may be requested to take a second test upon landing in Dubai, after which you must self-isolate until receiving the results.
- Persons arriving in Dubai and travelling on to Abu Dhabi;
  - Travelers from pre-approved countries, must self-isolate until receive a negative test result
  - Travelers from other countries, must self-isolate for 10 days
- Persons may spend 10 days in Dubai prior to travelling to Abu Dhabi without quarantine requirements.

### Quarantine Exemption

- The Organizing Authority is working with local authorities to gain exemption from self-isolation.
- This option will be available under strict regulations if arriving and departing within these dates:
  - Arrival Dates: 12 / 13 / 14 February 2021
  - Departure Date: 21 / 22 February 2021
- Further details to follow.

## Visa Requirements

Visa requirements remain the same for travel to the UAE. It will be the responsibility of the participants to make their own arrangements to obtain a valid visa to the UAE. The OA may provide a letter of invitation if required.

## Process to enter Abu Dhabi from Dubai

- To enter Abu Dhabi from Dubai, travellers will be required to;
  - Obtain a Negative PCR or DPI test result
  - Enter Abu Dhabi by presenting the test result at the checkpoint within 72 hours
  - When staying for 6 consecutive days, submit to a PCR test

## Pre-Event Training in Dubai

The Dubai Offshore Sailing Club has offered teams to make use of their club for pre-event training. Teams would be able to travel to Dubai and spend 10 days in Dubai Emirate prior to travelling on to Abu Dhabi.

### Abu Dhabi to welcome back international tourists

Starting 24 December 2020

International travellers will be required to:

#### Before Departure

- 1 Present a negative PCR test result received within 96 hours of their scheduled departure

#### Upon Arrival

- 2 Take a second PCR test upon landing in the emirate

#### Self-isolate

- 3 For travellers from 'green' countries – until they receive a negative test result  
For travellers from other countries – for 10 days

Country classifications will be reviewed every two weeks

#### Day six and day twelve

- 4 Take a PCR test on day six for those staying for six days or more, and on day 12 for those staying for 12 days or more

**Approved procedures by the Abu Dhabi Emergency, Crisis and Disasters Committee for entering the emirate from 24 December 2020**

**Negative test result**

**PCR or DPI**

**First 72 hours**

**Day six**

**1** Take a COVID-19 test

**2** Entry to the emirate within 72 hours of receiving a negative test result

**3** PCR test is mandatory on day 6 of entering

> when staying for 6 or more consecutive days

Rules apply to all UAE citizens and residents, including returning Abu Dhabi residents

**Those failing to take the PCR test on day 6 are liable for fines**

**Example:**

If entering Abu Dhabi on Sunday (day 1) and staying for 6 or more days, a PCR test is mandatory on Friday (day 6)
