BBYC SAFETY PLAN

1. Chain of command

Regatta Chair - Course PRO – Safety 1 – Safety team

2. Safety Plan – General

- a. Follow Chain of Command. Safety 1 coordinate with PRO.
- b. Safety 1 make assignments for course.
- c. Safety Boats remain in area except as reassigned by Safety 1.
- d. Use safety buoy for breakdowns and call for tow from BBYC if necessary.
- e. Safety boats remain on the water until all sailors are safe ashore.
- f. Hand Signals
 - 1. OK Pat open hand on top of head.
 - 2. Assistance Needed Wave closed fist over head.

3. Medical Plan

- a. Treat by first boat on scene and release.
- b. Treatment by Safety or Medical boat and release or transport to shore if needed.
- c. Injury requiring attention ashore.
 - i. Minor/ non-life threatening -
 - 1. Stabilize and transport to BBYC B Dock.
 - 2. Patient can be transfer to medical boat for transport if safe to do so or EMT can transfer to Safety Boat.
 - 3. Safety 1 Call for EMS if necessary and notify BBYC and PRO on VHF 14.
 - 4. Call 2nd Safety boat to secure sailboat if necessary.
 - 5. Regatta Ashore Staff or Mgr. Contact patient's family.
 - 6. Club staff prepare for arrival of EMS unit at B Dock
 - ii. Severe/Life Threatening
 - 1. Stabilize and transport to BBYC B Dock.

- 2. Safety 1 or designee calls BBYC Ashore Staff to request EMS response.
- 3. Patient can be transferred to medical boat for transport if safe to do so or EMT can transfer to Safety Boat. Do not delay care or transport awaiting Medical Boat.
- 4. PRO notify BBYC on VHF 14.
- 5. Call 2nd Safety boat to secure sailboat if necessary.
- 6. Ashore Regatta Staff or Mgr. contact patient's family.
