FACTS FOUND

Boat 2 was approaching from starboard side sailing starboard tack. boat 276 approaching from port side in port tack. Crossing courses. Collision occurred and kites were tangled. They untangled the lines and continue the race and he finished in the last part of the fleet.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

276 on port failed to keep clear of 2 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.

It was not reasonably possible for 2, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with 276 when it was clear that 276 was not keeping clear. 2 did not break RRS 14.

2's score in race 3 was made significantly worse through no fault of her own by a tangle because of the action of 276 that was breaking a rule of Part 2.

DECISION

276 DCT for the race 3.

2 is given redress in race 3 according to F5 62 and A10 b.
