FACTS FOUND

79, 721 and 5 were sailing to the starting line starboard course overlapped, 79 windward, 721 leeward of 79 and windward of 5. 3 sec after starting signal, kite of 79 tangled with both 721 and 5 kites, causing fall of all kites. 721 after untangling started the race but after the snowboards have started. 79 retired cause 3 lines were broken. 5 untangled 4 minutes after the incident and also retired.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

79 to windward failed to keep clear of 721 and 5 to leeward, and broke RRS 11 and 14. It was not reasonably possible for 721 and 5, the right-of-way boats to avoid contact with 79 when it was clear that 79 was not keeping clear. 721 and 5 did not break RRS 14. 721's and 5's scores in race 2 was made significantly worse through no fault of their own by a tangle because of the action of 79 that was breaking a rule of Part 2.
