PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

Windspeed was 12 knots on the first run

JPN 7 was 2 boat lengths clear ahead of CHN 67 on port and 1 boat length apart

JPN 7 gybed on to Starboard and then CHN 67 gybed on to Starboard, overlapped to windward of JPN 7.

JPN 7 luffed 10 degrees and sailed higher and on a converging course with CHN 67

After CHN 67 luffed JPN 7 came within 30 cms of CHN 67

JPN 7 bore away

There was no contact and no boat took a penalty.
