FACTS FOUND

in race 3 of ski fleet 10sec to start, 333 snowboard which was not in the particular division and race, was sailing on port towards to the ski fleet crossing course with both 122 and 77 who were sailing starboard. 122 was windward and 77 leeward. 122 stopped and avoid 333 but did not avoid 77. 122 tangled with 77. 122 retired from race 3 because his kite lines were damaged beyond repair. He fixed his kite lines row after race 3 but there were problems in race 4 because of this incident. he managed finally to completely fix it for race 5 and so on. kite 77 retired in race 3 due to the long time he needed to untangle his lines.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. Since snowboard 333 was not racing but had been racing, and the incident caused serious damage, the preamble to RRS Part 2 applies.
- 2. snowboard 333 who was not racing, interfered with boats 122 and 77 who was racing, even thought it was reasonably possible to avoid them, and broke RRS 24.1.
- 3. snowboard 333 on port failed to keep clear of skis 122 and 77 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
- 4. 122 was compelled to break RRS 11 and RRS 14 by the actions of snowboard 333 breaking RRS 10.
- 5. It was not reasonably possible for 122 and 77 to avoid contact. 122 and 77 did not break RRS 14.
- 6. 122's scores in races 3 and 4 and 77's scores in race 3 was made significantly worse through no fault of their own by a tangle because of the action of 333 that was breaking a rule of Part 2.

DECISION

snowboard 333 is to be scored DSQ in race 2. ski 122 is given redress in race 3 and 4 according to A10b. ski 77 is given redress in race 3 according to A10b.
