PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. 16-18kt of breeze with an ebb tide and heavy swell.

- 2. Etchells EAUS849 rounded Mk.1 and 1a ahead of 29er 2464, and set a symmetrical spinnaker.
- 3. After setting an asymmetrical spinnaker 2464 changed course to windward, converging with EAUS849.
- 4. 2464 in changing course sailed into the wind shadow of EAUS849 and there was a collision between the boats.
- 4. There was serious damage to 2464 and the skipper of 2464 was injured.

5. Both boats retired.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. 2464 did not give EAUS849 room to keep clear, RRS 16.1.

2. It was not reasonably possible for EAUS849 to to avoid contact and keep clear of 2464, definition of keep clear and RRS 14, 62.1(b).

DECISION

1. As both boats retired no further penalty is applied.

2. Redress denied.
