PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. On the final downwind leg in R7, CHN was windward and THA leeward
- 2. Both were initially on starboard. THA was slightly ahead
- 3. Wind speed was 14 knots and both helm and crew were on the trapeze for both boats.
- 4. THA gybed to port
- 5. CHN gybed at the same time to port and both became abeam of each other with CHN windward.
- 6. There was initially a distance of half a boat length between the THA's crew's head and the gennaker of CHN
- 7. THA and CHN continued to sail overlapped, side by side and gradually converged.
- 8. CHN gennaker then touched THA crew's head.
- 9. Shortly after, CHN finished 3 boat lengths ahead of THA
- 10. There was no damage or injury. No boats carried out any penalty turn.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. CHN to windward failed to keep clear of THA to leeward, and broke RRS 11.
- 2. CHN also broke rule 14.
- 3. THA broke RRS 14, but is exonerated under RRS 14.b.
