FACTS FOUND

- 1. 405 was sailing close-hauled on starboard approaching the shore.
- 2. 44 was on starboard to leeward by 15 feet and overlapped with 405
- 3. 44 hailed for room to tack and stated she felt it necessary to tack to avoid going aground.
- 4. 405 did not respond.
- 5. After 15 to 30 seconds 44 ran aground and remained there for 2 to 3 minutes.
- 6. 405 tacked and sailed on aware that 44 had run aground.
- 7. It is unknown if there is damage to 44 or if it affected the performance of 44.

405 failed to properly respond to 44's hail for room and broke RRS 20.2(c).

At the time of the hearing it is unknown whether there is damage or injury and whether 44 qualifies for redress under RRS 62.1(b).
