5 SCHEDULE

- 5.8 There will be a daily competitors briefing at 10:00 in front of the race office, except otherwise stated on the official notice board.
- 5.9 No warning signal will be made before 12:00 hours except otherwise posted on the official notice board.

7 STARTING AND FINISHING

- 7.6 The finishing line will be between a blue/white chequered flag on the finish race committee vessel and the course side of the nearby finish mark.
- 7.7 The finishing line race committee vessel is identified by a blue/white chequered flag. This changes RRS Race Signals.

This changes NoR/SI 7.6 and 7.7

- 8.1 Time limits and target times, in minutes, are as follows:

11 COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 11.1 The Official Notice board is online at www.formulakite.com/onb. Courtesy information will be posted on the Notice Board on the windows of the race office.
The Official Flag Pole is located in front of the race office. Courtesy shore flag signals will be displayed at a flag pole in the launching area.
- 11.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in the race signal AP. This changes Race Signals.

18 PROTESTS, PENALTIES AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 18.1.1 For each fleet, the protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last kiteboard has finished the last race of the day for that Class, or when AP over A, or N over A is displayed.
