PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. 29er 11 was originally scored 3 and 29er 2461 was originally scored 4 in race 2.
2. The whole 29er fleet except first place, 2240 and 2546 score was worsened by 2 points by the decision of the Jury in hearing 2/3.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. The decision of Hearing 2/3 was not as fair an arrangement as possible for all boats affected as required by rule 64.2. This was an improper action of the Jury.

DECISION

Redress is granted.

2240 and 2546 score is to remain as 2 and 3 respectively and the finishing positions for race 2 as otherwise originally scored shall stand.
