



Amendment No. 1 to the 2018 Atlantic Anniversary Regatta

Bermuda to Hamburg/Cuxhaven

Notice of Race

Amend 5.3.1 – Divisions – Cruising Division to read:

Open to boats with either an IRC Certificate with a rating between 1.004 and 1.050 or an ORC Certificate with a Long Distance Scoring Coefficient between 0.950 and 1.000. The committee may make exceptions on application.

The Cruising Division will race for a different set of trophies.

Note: The Organising Committee values the commitment of the entirely Corinthian applicants for the Cruising division and has thus waived the limitation of 6 boats to form this division. There will be a start on Sunday 1st July to allow the slower boats to take part in the celebration in Hamburg.

Add to 13.1 Outside Assistance:

Specifically excluded is the application of human intelligence to the particular position or situation of the boat in the race to obtain advice on strategy or tactics.

Note: The relaxation of outside assistance is a tribute to the advances in technical developments. This rule will allow you to use e.g. routing software that is offered as a “Software-as-a-Service”, or to obtain help in troubleshooting critical systems such as watermakers, hydraulics or electronics that may be required for the safety on board during an Atlantic crossing. However, in the spirit of the gentleman-sports of sailing, the decisions with regards to strategy and tactics should still be made whilst being part of the team on board of the boat instead of delegating this to “unofficial” crew members ashore.
