56314 on starboard tack was waiting for the starting signal. Then 56001 on port tack came fast toward 56314 and 56314 hailed "Starboard" 3 times. But 56001 didn't change course and kept on sailing to 56314, so pushed rudder rapidly and hailed "starboard and Protest"

Red Flag Displayed: Not required

PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1, A video of the incident was presented by the Jury who witnessed the incident. See attached video.

FACTS FOUND

1. 56314 was stationary on starboard tack at the starting line.
2. 56001 was reaching on port tack, in converging course with 56314.
3. 56001 tacked clear ahead of 56314, with a distance of half a boat length in between.
4. 56314 pulled her sails, slightly gained speed and luffed.
5. No contact occurred and neither boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. 56001 kept clear of 56314 when she was tacking, as required by RRS 13.
2. When 56001 completed her tack and acquired right of way, she initially gave 56314 room to keep-clear as required by RRS 15.
3. No rules were broken in the incident.
