PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. Wind was 4-6 knots, sea relatively calm.

- 2. On the first beat just outside the zone of mark 1, 56314 was on port and converging with 55246 on starboard.
- 3. About one boat length from 55246, 56314 bore down sharply to pass the stern of 55246.
- 4. When 56314 was about to pass the transom of 55246, 55246 tacked to lee bow 56314.
- 5. 56314 responded immediately by luffing up.
- 6. Before 55246 completed her tack, light contact took place between the starboard bow of 56314 and the rear port quarter of 55246.
- 7. There was no damage or injury and no boat took any penalty turns.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. When 56314 bore off she was sailing a course to pass the stern of 55246.
- 2. When 55246 altered course to tack, 56314 was forced to immediately luff in an attempt to keep clear. 55246 therefore broke RRS16.2.
- 3. After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, 55246 failed to keep clear of 56314 on a tack, and broke RRS13
- 4. It was not reasonably possible for 56314 to avoid contact with 55246 the tacking and keep clear boat and therefore 56314 is exonerated under RRS14(b).

DECISION

Case 8 Protest Upheld. 55246 is DSQ in Race 8. Case 9 Protest Dismissed.
