214460 was waiting for the boats rounding the leeward mark. Then 211040 barged between 214460 and the boat ahead. 211040 was not overlapped with 214460 and 211040 bore away rapidly to avoid contact.

## PROCEDURAL MATTERS

### FACTS FOUND

1. 214460 and 211040 were running to the leeward mark in race 2 both initially on starboard tack with 211040 astern
2. At the zone 214460 was ahead of 211040
3. 214460 had to go wide as there were 3 boats ahead in the queue with mark room to round the leeward mark
4. When giving the 3 boats mark room, 214460 left the zone.
5. 214460 then gybed to port to round the mark gave an inside overlap to 211040, the latter still outside the zone..
6. 214460 gave little room for 211040 to round the mark causing 211040 to luff suddenly to avoid contact and almost touched the mark in doing so.
7. There was no contact and no boats did any penalty turns.

### CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. 214460, as the outside overlapped boat failed to give 211040 mark-room, as required by RRS 18.2(b) forcing 211040 to take action to avoid contact.
2. 211040 failed to keep clear of 214460 and broke RRS 10.
