PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. FRA 127 and POL 107 were sailing on port, close hauled, FRA 127 to windward of POL 107
- 2. POL 107 lifted her kite and gybed to starboard
- 3. FRA 127 lifted her kite immediately, she capsized and was not able to recover
- 4. POL 107 finished the race but FRA 127 did not
- 5. There was no damage or injury and no kiteboard took a penalty

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. POL 107, right of way, changed the position of her kite without giving room to FRA 127 to keep clear, breaking rule 16.1
- 2. The score of FRA 127 was not made significantly worse in race 19 through no fault of her own by a tangle, damage or injury caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2

POL is DSQ in race 19 FRA 127 is not given redress
