PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Before the start of Race 6, 204389 was to windward of 199268, both on starboard tack.
- 2. About 30 seconds before the start, 204389 bore away hard and capsized to windward.
- 3. When 204389 capsized, the top of her mast struck the tiller of 199268, breaking the tiller extension fitting and the rudder gudgeon fitting.
- 4. A general recall was signalled.
- 5. 199268 was unable to start in the re-started race.
- 6. 204389 started and finished the re-started race.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

204389 a windward boat failed to keep clear of 199268. 204389 broke rule 11.

It was not reasonably possible for 199268, a right of way boat, to avoid contact. 199268 did not break rule 14.

204389 caused serious damage to 199268. 204389 broke rule 14.

204389 is disqualified from race 6 for breaking rule 14.

199268 is granted redress under rule 62.1(b) as follows:

For race 6, 199268 is to be scored the average of all her races in the regatta excluding race 6 and excluding the races conducted on the last day.
