PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. ESP 67 was fetching mark 1
- 2. THA 42 was sailing on port on collision course
- 3. ESP 67 lifted her kite and slowed down
- 4. Contact occurred between the kites
- 5. THA 42 continued and finished the race
- 6. ESP 67 capsized and finished the race
- 7. No damage, injury or tangle occurred, no kiteboard took a penalty

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. THA 42 on port did not keep clear of ESP 67 on starboard breaking rule 10
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for ESP 67 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14
- 3. The score of ESP 67 was not made significantly worse in race F5 through no fault of their own by a tangle, damage or injury caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2

DECISION

THA 42 is DSQ in race F5 ESP 67 is not given redress
