### PROCEDURAL MATTERS

#### FACTS FOUND

1. ITA 6 and NZL 9 were sailing on a beat, ITA 6 on starboard and NZL 9 on port on collision course

- 2. NZL 9 tacked to starboard leeward and ahead of ITA 6 and fell of her foil.
- 3. ITA 6 luffed and lifted her kite and immediately there was contact between the kites
- 4. There was damage in the bridles of ITA 6 and she did not finish the race

#### CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. NZL 9 acquired right of way without giving room to ITA 6 to keep clear, breaking rule 15 and 14
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for ITA 6 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14

3. The score of ITA 6 was made significantly worse in race 3 through no fault of her own by damage caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2

NZL 9 is DSQ in race 3 ITA 6 is given redress in race 3 and will be scored points equal to the average of her scores in the other races of the day rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other kiteboards.
