- 5. GER 733 lodged the request as soon as possible after coming ashore.
- 6. It is a good reason to extend the time limit, therefore the request is valid.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Flag U was used as the preparatory signal in race 4 of J70 class.
- 2. RC identified GER 733 in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark within the last minute before her starting signal from both ends of the starting line.
- 3. RC scored GER 733 as UFD in race 4.
- 4. No rule requires the RC to inform the boats that were scored UFD.

- 1. By scoring GER 733 UFD in race 4 the RC complied with RRS 30.3 and therefore acted properly.
