### **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

### **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. The hearing opened at 8.05am on 07/01/2018 and after taking evidence from the parties, was adjourned at 9.30am.
- 2. The hearing reconvened at 9.30am on 08/01/2018 with all parties present.
- 3. At the start of race 3, AUS016, AUS037, AUS060, AUS051 and AUS053 were identified on course side of the start line by the Race Committee.
- 4. AUS037, AUS060 and AUS051 did not believe they were on course side of the start line at the start.
- 5. The pin boat testified that they did not hear a sound signal after the start signal but did see code flag X displayed.
- 6. Video evidence played by the competitors and audio played by the pin boat establish a clearly audible sound signal for the start of race 3.
- 7. No other sound signal can be heard in the video or audio evidence.
- 8. Code flag X was displayed on the RCV without a prompt sound signal.
- 9. Code flag X remained displayed for approximately 7 minutes.
- 10. AUS037, AUS060, AUS051 and AUS053 did not return to start and finished race 3.
- 11. AUS037, AUS060, AUS051 and AUS053 were scored OCS in race 3.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. The absence of a sound signal with the display of code flag X is an improper action of the Race Committee under rule 29.1.
- 2. AUS037, AUS060, AUS051 and AUS053 scores through no fault of their own have been made significantly worse by an improper action or omission of the race committee.

### DECISION

AUS037, AUS060, AUS051 and AUS053 are granted redress under rule 62.1(a).

Each boat is to be awarded points equal to their finishing place in race 3 plus 3 points, limited to a maximum of 16 points.

No other boats scores shall be affected.
