PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. AUS016 was identified by the Race Committee as being on course side of the start line at the start of race 5.
- 2. AUS016 knew she was on course side of the start line.
- 3. A sound signal was made approximately 2 seconds after the start.
- 4. Code flag X was displayed 19 seconds after the start signal.
- 5. AUS016 did not return to the pre-start side of the start line and finished race 5.
- 6. AUS016 testified that "we knew we were over, didn't want an OCS and would have returned if we had seen the flag promptly".

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. The display of code flag X 19 seconds after the start is not prompt as required by rule 29.1 and is an improper action of the Race Committee.
- 2. By failing to start correctly AUS016 knowingly broke rule 28.1.
- 3. AUS016 score of OCS is not through no fault of her own.
- 4. AUS016, a boat that knowingly broke a rule breaches the Basic Principle, Sportsmanship and the Rules and breaks rule 2.

DECISION

AUS016 is to be scored DNE for race 5.

Redress is denied.
