PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The hearing was conducted without the protestee under RRS 63.3(b).
- 2. USA 381 was sailing on starboard approaching the second windward mark.
- 3. ARG 188 was sailing on port on a collision course with USA 381.
- 4. ARG 188 tacked to leeward of USA 381 but collided with USA 381 prior to completing her tack.
- 5. ARG 188 made contact with USA 381 2 to 3 feet from her stern on the port quarter.
- 6. USA 381 suffered damage in the form of cracked gel coat and compressed laminate as a result of the collision.
- 7. Neither boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, ARG 188 failed to keep clear of USA 381, as required by RRS 13.
- 2. ARG 188 failed to avoid contact with USA 381 as required by RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for USA 381, the right-of-way boat, to avoid contact with ARG 188 when it was clear that ARG 188 was not keeping clear.

DECISIONProtest Upheld.

ARG 188 to be scored DSQ for race 3.
