PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. CHI 1038 was on port approaching the finish on a reach.
- 2. USA 340 was on starboard on a collision course with CHI 1038.
- 3. USA 1042 was on starboard slightly bow out and to windward of USA 340, also on a collision course with CHI 1038
- 4. CHI 1038 entered the zone overlapped with USA 1042 and USA 340.
- 5. USA 1042 and USA 340 jibed as they entered the zone.
- 6. CHI 1038 and USA 1042 collided side to side as they neared the finish line.
- 7. CHI 1038 collided with the pin end committee boat.
- 8. The collision with the committee boat caused a hole in CHI 1038's hull.
- 9. No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- $1. \ \ USA\ 340, as\ outside\ overlapped\ boat\ at\ the\ zone,\ failed\ to\ give\ USA\ 1042\ mark-room,\ as\ required\ by\ RRS\ 18.2(b)$
- 2. USA 1042, as outside overlapped boat at the zone, failed to give CHI 1038 mark-room, as required by RRS 18.2(b), but is exonerated under RRS 21.
- 3. USA 1042 failed to avoid contact with CHI 1038 as required by RRS 14.
- 4. USA 1038 failed to avoid contact with a mark of the course as required by RRS 31 but is exonerated under RRS 21.
- 5. It was not reasonably possible for CHI 1038, a boat entitled to mark-room, to avoid contact with USA 1042 when it was clear that USA 1042 was not giving mark-room.
- 6. USA 1038's score was not made significantly worse by the damage caused from the collision with the committee boat.
