## PROCEDURAL MATTERS

## **FACTS FOUND**

Ron Wood, a member of the jury, witnessed the incident and notified the parties in accordance with rule 63.6.

FRA 115 approached the windward mark for the first time in race 7 on port tack.

She luffed within the zone and then tacked on to starboard below the starboard layline.

She tacked again on to port close to the mark, inside of two other boats that had been on starboard since entering the zone.

After sailing two boatlengths, she tacked again onto starboard, still inside the other two boats.

During that third tack she slowed considerably.

When she was at the mark, she touched it amidships with her port hull.

She did not take any penalty turn.
