FACTS FOUND

On registration day, VEN 246 presented the OA with a selection of boards and asked which one was valid. The representative of the OA pointed out an F1 board and VEN 246 competed using that board on the first three races of the competition. On the morning of the third day of competition, the OA asked VEN 246 to find a valid board. Following that, VEN 246 registered an Axis Limited board and competed with that board in races 4 and 5.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

VEN 246 sailed in races 1, 2 and 3 with unregistered equipment breaking class rule C1.1(a)(1) VEN 246 sailed with a registered board in races 4 and 5 VEN 246 thought that the board she was using in races 1, 2, and 3 was registered equipment due to the confirmation from the OA. It was the responsibility of VEN 246 to comply with class rules according to rule 78.1
