## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. Before the warning signal for race 1 of the day in the starting area, Sabot 1365 was reaching on starboard tack on a collision course bow to bow with with Optimist 1355 reaching on port tack.
- 2. 1355 held her course and 1365 bore away sharply to avoid a collision.
- 3. There was contact between the port side bow of 1355 and the starboard quarter gunnel of 1365 causing serious damage to 1365.
- 4. No boat took a penalty.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. The boats were sailing in the racing area intending to race.
- 2. 1355 on port tack failed to keep clear of 1365 on starboard tack, as required by rule 10. 1355 broke rule 10
- 3. The contact between the boats caused serious damage to 1365.
- 4. It was not reasonably possible for 1365, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with 1355 when it was clear that 1355, the keep clear boat was not keeping clear. 1365 did not break rule 14.
- 5. It was reasonably possible for 1355, the keep clear boat to avoid contact with 1365, the right of way boat. 1355 broke rule 14.

1355 is DSQ from race 3.
