PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. 15 seconds before the start on the pre-start side of the start line with 18 knots of wind and waves, JPN 117 was stationery on starboard tack with boats either side of her.
- 2. The crew of JPN 117 were standing up in the boat with the sails on the port side.
- 3. JPN 117 moved astern slowly without backing her sails.
- 4. AUS 14 on port tack initially bore away to pass astern of the starboard tack boats including JPN 117.
- 5. AUS 14 altered her course slightly to weather, was hit by a gust of wind, losing control and rounds up.
- 6. Shortly thereafter, contact occurred between JPN 117 port wing and AUS 14 port bow causing damage to the foot-strap and port wing of JPN 117 and damage to the port side hull near the bow of AUS 14.
- 7. JPN 117 did not to start.
- 8. AUS 14 completed the race.
- 9. Neither boat completed a penalty turn.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. AUS 14 on port failed to keep clear of JPN 117 on starboard as required by rule 10.
- 2. AUS 14 did not avoid contact with JPN 117 when it was reasonably possible to do so as required by rule 14.
- 3. The contact caused damage to both boats.
- 4. It was not reasonably possible for JPN 117, the right of way boat, to avoid contact with AUS 14.
- 5. JPN 117 score in the race, through no fault of her own, was made significantly worse by physical damage because of the action of AUS 14 that was breaking a rule of Part 2.

DECISION

AUS 14 is DSQ in race 9

Redress given to JPN 117. JPN 117 is to be scored in race 9, points equal to the average, to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward), of her points in all the races before the race in question.
