- entangled.
- 6. Mr. McClellend remained in place of the windward mark with the M flag displayed until another RC boat freed the mark and approached to set it.
- 7. The RC replaced the mark in the same position it had been originally.
- 8. This was completed before Godot made her second rounding of the weather mark.
