PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Both on board; no objections to jurors;

The SIs delete the US Sailing prescription to RRS 63.2.

The SIs 18.2 specified that RRS 44.3 applied.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind speed 13 knts gusting to 16 knts. Seas were calm.
- 2. Boat speed: Aeolos (Beneteau F44.7) 8 knts, B'Quest (Tripp 40) similar speed
- 3. The boats were on the first leg (Start to Mark 3) of the course.
- 4. Both boats were beam reaching on stbd tack, flying asym spinnakers.
- 5. Aeolos was just clear astern of B'Quest and 10-12 feet to windward.
- 6. B'Quest luffed rapidly (rounded up) in front of Aeolos.
- 7. Aeolos bore off to pass astern of B'Quest.
- 8. Aeolos' bow made contact with B'Quest's stbd side approximately 1 ft from the stern.
- 9. Aeolos' spinnaker pole and sprit pole were broken and anchor roller was damaged.
- 10. Aeolos was unable to fly her spinnaker following the incident.
- 11. B'Quest took a 1 turn penalty after the incident.
- 12. Both boats finished the race.
- 13. Aeolos withdrew her request for redress.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. Aeolos to windward failed to keep clear of B'Quest to leeward, and broke RRS 11.
- 2. When changing course B'Quest, the right-of-way boat, failed to give Aeolos room to keep clear, and broke RRS 16.1.
- 3. Aeolos is exonerated per RRS 43.1(a) for breaking RRS 11.
- 4. Aeolos could not have reasonably avoided contact and did not break RRS 14.
- 5. B'Ouest could have avoided contact and broke RRS 14 and is not exonerated.
- 6. The damage to Aeolos is considered 'serious' (see WS Case 141).
- 7. Since B'Quest caused serious damage by her breach, her penalty was to retire as required by RRS 44.1(b).
