# **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

#### **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. The wind was light with an adverse current.
- 2. Eyrie was sailing at about 2 knots downwind on starboard with her spinnaker up.
- 3. Basic Instinct was on port sailing downwind on a collision course with Eyrie.
- 4. As the boats converged, Eyrie altered down to avoid Basic Instinct.
- 5. When Eyrie altered, the boats were at least several boat lengths from the edge of shallow water.
- 6. The boats continued to sail on opposite tacks within about 5 feet of each other until Eyrie gybed.
- 7. Just after Eyrie gybed, Eyrie was in close proximity to windward of Basic Instinct and Basic Instinct hit the bottom in soft mud in the shallow water.
- 8. Both boats finished the race and neither boat took a penalty.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. Basic Instinct failed to keep clear of Eyrie as required by RRS 10 (because Basic Instinct was not yet at the obstruction and thus did not yet get room).
- 2. Eyrie failed to give room to Basic Instinct when Basic Instinct was at the obstruction as required by RRS 19.2.
