2. Respondent, SGP 4486 was not present and the hearing proceeded under RRS 63.3(b).

FACTS FOUND

1) During the finishing of Race 8 for the Opti Silver, the RC identified SGP 3256, SGP 4682, SGP 4685, SGP 4486 and SGP 3198 touched the RC finishing vessel whilst racing.

2) The finishing line was a RC vessel to port and a blue buoy to starboard.

- 3) The current was pushing boats in the direction from the blue buoy towards the RC vessel.
- 4) SGP 3256, SGP 4682, SGP 4685, SGP 4486 touched the RC vessel before crossing the finishing line.
- 5) SGP 3198 touched the RC vessel after he finished but before he could clear the finishing marks RC vessel.
- 6) Neither boats took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

SGP 3256, SGP 4682, SGP 4685, SGP 4486 and SGP 3198 touched a finishing mark whilst racing and broke RRS 31.
