PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. On the run, FRA 118 and GER 115 were sailing on port, FRA 118 to windward of GER 115, 80 meters apart
- 2. GER 115 gybed to starboard, crashed and her kite moved to 12 o'clock
- 3. FRA 118 gybed to starboard, on collision course with GER 115
- 4. 3 seconds after GER 115 crashed, there was contact and the kites tangled.
- 5. No kiteboard finished the race but there was no damage or injury

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. Although it was possible, FRA 118 did not avoid GER 115, a kiteboard that was capsized, breaking rules 23.1 and 14.
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for GER 115 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14
- 3. The score of GER 115 was made significantly worse in race 14 through no fault of their own by a tangle caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2

DECISION

FRA 118 is RCT in race 14

GER 115 is given redress and will be scored points equal to the average of her scores in the other races of the day rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other kiteboards.
