PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. SLO 119 and THA122 were sailing on starboard. SLO 119 was fetching the mark and was to windward and astern of THA 122 that was not fetching the mark

- 2. THA 122 tacked to port, there was immediate contact and the kites tangled
- SLO 119 did not finish the race
- 4. THA 122 recovered and finished the race
- 5. There was no damage and no kiteboard took a penalty

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. THA 122 on port did not keep clear of SLO 119 on starboard breaking rules 10 and 14
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for SLO 119 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14

of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other kiteboards.

3. The score of SLO 119 was made significantly worse in race 14 through no fault of their own by a tangle caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2
