FACTS FOUND

- 1. ISCYRA granted permission to use STCR 34.3.7, Format B for racing.
- 2. STCR 34.3.7, Format B specifies a maximum time limit of 3 hours.
- 3. ISCYRA did not grant permission to change the time limit in Format B.
- 4. SI 15.1 stated that the time limit for the first boat to finish was two hours.
- 5. Race 2 was not abandoned by the RC, and no boats retired from the race..

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. RRS 87 says in part: '...the sailing instructions may change a class rule only when the class rules permit the change...'
- 2. SI 15.1 changed the time limit for the race contrary to STCR 34.3.7, Format B.
- 3. For the purposes of RRS 35, the 3-hour time limit in Format B was the applicable time limit.
- 4. Therefore, the RC complied with RRS 35.
- 5. The RC acted properly by not abandoning the race and scoring all boats.

Redress not granted.
