









# 23<sup>rd</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> of July 2019 NOTICE OF RACE

## 1. **VENUE:**

- **1.1** The M'diq International Regatta SNIM 2019 will be held from the  $23^{rd}$  to the  $28^{th}$  of July 2019 in M'diq, in the north Morocco (On the Mediterranean See).
- **1.2** Attachment A1 shows the location of the regatta harbor, and the racing areas.

## 2. ORGANIZING AUTORITY:

The organizing authority is the Association Royal Yacht Club of M'diq, under the authority of to the National Sailing Federation "Fédération Royale Marocaine de Voile" (FRMV).

## 3. RULES:

- **3.1** The SNIM 2019 will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS 2017-2020).
- 3.2 Optimist and Laser class Rules will apply for their respective classes.

## 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- **4.1** The regatta is open to boats of the following classes in the limit of availability:
  - **4.1.1 Optimist:** Competitors in the Optimist class must be born after 31/12/2004. **4.1.2 Laser 4.7:** Competitors in the Laser 4.7 class must be under 18 years of age.
  - **4.1.3 Laser Radial:** Entries in the Laser Radial class are OPEN.
  - **4.1.4** Proof of age is to be presented at registration
- **4.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it to the organizing authority by the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2019.
- **4.3** Registrations are open to boats and competitors that comply with world sailing regulations.

## 5. <u>FEES:</u>

- **5.1** Registrations are free in the form of packages for 5 persons: 4 sailors and 1 official. Accommodations are free for 4 sailors and 1 official (in double or triple rooms). Lunch boxes will be distributed to all sailors each day.
- **5.2** For an extra family member or an extra sailor, entries are fixed in the form of packages at USD 500\$ each.

- 7.2 On the reserve day, in case it is used for racing, no warning signal will be made after 15H00.
- **7.3** The Organizing Authority and the Race Committee reserve the right to modify the above program according to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

#### 7. INTERNATIONAL JURY:

An International Jury will be constituted in accordance with RRS Appendix N. Decisions of the Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

## 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The sailing instructions will be available during registration at the race office or on our website <a href="www.royalyachtmdiq.com">www.royalyachtmdiq.com</a>, other documents governing the event will be published with the sailing instructions.

## 9. SOCIAL EVENT PROGRAM:

Opening and closing ceremonies are scheduled, other social events will be planned as part of the regatta's social program. The program will be posted on the official notice board and on the regatta's website.

## 10. BOATS & EQUIPMENT:

The organizing authority has a limited number of boats. Each country can potentially have two **Optimists**, one **Laser 4.7** and one **Laser Radial**.

- **10.1** A refundable damage deposit of **150** € per boat will be collected during registration.
- **10.2** The deposit is the maximum payable fee by sailors as a result of any incident.
- 10.3 You must bring: Sails for Optimist with Numbers and National Letters.

Sails and Tillers for Laser with Numbers and National Letters.

## 11. SCORING:

- **11.1** The Low Point System of appendix A will be used.
- 11.2 4 races are required to be completed in each class to constitute a series for that class.
- 11.3 When 4 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- **11.4** When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 12. SUPPORT BOATS:

Team leaders, coaches and other support persons shall stay outside the area where boats are racing; from the first preparatory signal of the first class, until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

## **13. PRIZES:**

- 13.1 Optimist  $1^{st} 2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  Mixed Overall plus Youngest sailor.
- **13.2** Laser 4.7  $1^{\text{st}} 2^{\text{nd}}$  and  $3^{\text{rd}}$  Mixed Overall.
- **13.3** Laser Radial  $1^{st} 2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  Mixed Overall plus  $1^{st}$  Female.
- 13.4 Souvenirs will be awarded to all participants (Sailors and Officials).

### 14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Participants compete entirely at their own risk. See RRS4, Decision to Race. The organizing committee and all others involved in the organization of the SNIM, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 15. INSURANCE:

Competitors must carry property and liability insurance covering all risks. Insurance may be bought at the regatta.

## 16. TRANSPORTATION:

Local transportation will be provided by the organizers to the Mohamed V International Airport of Casablanca or to the Ibn Batouta International Airport of Tangier.

## 17. NATIONAL FLAG:

Each team is requested to bring its own National Flag (100 x 150 cm).
